THE SCHOLARSHIP OFFER WILL BE CONTIGENT UPON PROVIDING PROOF OF ENROLLMENT AND WILL BE PAID DIRECTLY TO THE INSTITUTION YOU WILL BE ATTENDING. THE NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE.

1. Scholarship Program Objectives

The George A. Nikolopoulos Endowment Fund was established to promote, encourage, induce and advance Greek education. The main objectives of the fund are as follows:

- To provide scholarships for Universities to students who attended the Holy Trinity Greek School (HTGS) for at least six (6) years and graduated from it or have an interest in
- starting and/or continuing Hellenic Studies
- To provide funds for transportation expenses to the HTGS students who participate in exchange programs with sister schools in Greece.
- To provide funds for partial coverage of the expenses of the Greek school students who have been selected for programs of continuing education in Greece.
- To provide funds to cover the tuition fees of the Greek school for needy children.
- To provide funds to purchase a) educational equipment for the Greek School and b) Greek National costumes (Evzon-Amalia) to be kept at the Greek School and to be borrowed by the students for the Greek School programs (ex. 25th of March, 28th of October celebrations, etc.)

2. Eligibility

The applicant must satisfy any of the following:

- A High school senior or graduate planning to attend an accredited college or University who has also attended the HTGS for at least six years and graduated from it.
- A College student currently attending an accredited College or University and has attended the HTGS for at least six years.
- A prospective or current College student enrolled in Hellenic Studies.
- A Greek School student participating in an exchange program with a sister school in Greece to partially cover transportation expenses.
- Current or Graduate Greek school students who have been selected for programs of continuing education in Greece.
- HTGS students that show financial need to cover tuition expenses.

- Undergraduate II: College undergraduates (second semester freshmen, sophomores, juniors, or seniors) must submit official current college transcript.
- Graduate Students: must submit both official undergraduate college and graduate school transcripts, if applicable.

Note: All transcripts must be originals, not copies, and must be received by the application deadline

- A topic that addresses the benefits of the scholarship and your goals and objectives in college. The statement should highlight the applicant's ability to organize and communicate ideas and demonstrate composition and overall writing skills.
- Explaining how you will apply your scholarship to your Greek exchange program and what you expect to accomplish during your visit to Greece.
